WHO IS IT FOR?

This course is suited to all employees in the health and social care sector. In the UK over a million people are employed as carers and millions more provide informal care and support for relatives and friends. The Department of Health has drawn up a code of practice acknowledging that everyone involved in care provision needs training to tackle the risk of Health Care Acquired Infection (HCAI).

OBJECTIVES

This new CIEH qualification is designed as an introduction to hygiene and ensures that vulnerable people are not exposed to unnecessary risks. It will help everyone, including those in the private and voluntary healthcare sectors, to play their part in maintaining a clean and safe environment.

CONTENT

The qualification covers the following topics:

- Hygiene hazards
- Personal hygiene
- Cleaning

METHOD

Learners must attend the full session in order to qualify for the written examination at the end of the day. The examination will consist of thirty multiple choice questions and must be completed within one hour. Candidates that achieve 20 or more correct answers will pass the examination and receive a certificate.
