METHOD

The workshop identifies all the key legislative requirements where the need to carry out risk assessments are clearly detailed. Each of these is supported by worked examples to highlight the practical element of the workshop. Delegates are encouraged to bring along existing examples from their workplace to compare against 'best practice' examples.

Delivery is through a one-day training workshop followed by one-to-one tutor support. Delegates will be required to carry out a Risk Assessment and then prepare an outline report on key workplace activities to which the risk assessment applies. They will also need to complete a self-evaluation of their Risk Assessment process. A pass or credit pass is awarded to candidates who meet the course criteria by way of a written report and risk assessment study.
